Together with her colleagues, she founded the collective "24," which to date boasts 13 years of activity and exhibitions in public spaces in London such as Soho Square, Berkley Square and Trafalgar Square.

She returned to Naples in 2015 and founded Magazzini Fotografici, of which she is artistic director.

Author of photographic projects of international relevance (such as Crazy God awarded by the World Health Organization and shown at the World Conference on Poverty and Health in Venice) and several monographs.

Her photographs have been the subject of exhibitions, including collective ones alongside such names as Sebastiao Salgado and Steve McCurry and exhibited from Mexico to Great Britain and and and in several Italian cities.
